## **Drakenstein Lion Park CONTRACT & INDEMNITY FORM**

### **1) The Contract**

All persons applying for the Drakenstein Lion Park volunteer program must complete and sign application and indemnity forms. The person or persons who have signed the forms are hereafter referred to as the clients and/or applicants. The client agrees to be bound by these application conditions. No agent, representative or client of Drakenstein Lion Park has any right to alter, vary or waive any of these conditions. This contract, by whoever it is made and wherever it is made, is subject to and shall be governed and construed according to South African law.

### **2) Costs**

The charge for the volunteer program for a pre-determined period (starting on a Monday and ending on a Saturday) at Drakenstein Lion Park is R5000-00 for a two week stay and R10 000 for a four week stay, which covers the following:

- Accommodation.
- A scheduled shopping trip to town every week.
- A Volunteer T Shirt (which must be worn when working at the Park).

### **3) Accommodation**

Drakenstein Lion Park provides accommodation in the form of shared same sex units (maximum 2 persons). The kitchen is fully equipped with a gas stove and fridge. Volunteers are responsible for keeping the accommodation tidy at all times.

### **4) Payment / Acceptance of Application**

Signed and completed application and indemnity forms must be sent to Drakenstein Lion Park to qualify for our program. Once Drakenstein Lion Park approves an application and receives the client's non-refundable 100% deposit, confirmation of acceptance into the program will be sent to the client via e-mail.

### **5) Cancellation / Change by Client**

Any notification of cancellation must be in writing. In the event of cancellation 100% of the fee will be retained.

### **6) Cancellation by Drakenstein Lion Park**

Drakenstein Lion Park reserves the right to cancel the volunteer program. In the event of the program being cancelled for whatever reason, the client may receive a full refund of all moneys paid. No further liability by Drakenstein Lion Park to the client with regard to the cancellation will arise.

### **7) Unused Services**

In the event of a client failing to join a program, joining after commencement, or leaving prior to completion, Drakenstein Lion Park will accept no refunds or liability.

### **8) Changes**

Drakenstein Lion Park does not accept any liability arising out of changes to itineraries, or any other matters relating to the program, due to factors outside its control. These factors include wars, strikes, weather, political disputes, border closures, delayed flights, etc. Any expenses incurred by the client arising out of these changes are for their own account.

### **9) Travel Documents**

All clients must be in possession of medical/travel insurance, a valid passport, together with any necessary visas or required vaccinations, and the client accepts full responsibility for obtaining the same. Any information or advice given by Drakenstein Lion Park or its agents with regard to the above is given in good faith, but Drakenstein Lion Park can accept no responsibility for the information given. Should a client be refused entry to any country due to incorrect or incomplete documentation, Drakenstein Lion Park will not be held liable for any costs of such delays or repatriation costs for the client.

### **10) Unsuitability**

During the programme should a volunteer, in the sole opinion of Drakenstein Lion Park, be considered unsuitable for the programme due to being in contravention of any customs or laws of South Africa, or by reason of causing inconvenience or annoyance to other persons or behave in such a fashion as to endanger themselves or others, then we may disqualify the applicant. It must be noted that any volunteer seeking any form of physical contact with our lions or deemed to be compromising their well being will be disqualified from the programme immediately. In such circumstances transportation to the nearest town will be provided. Drakenstein Lion Park will not be liable to make any refund to the volunteer, and no other liability by Drakenstein Lion Park to the volunteer will arise.

### **11) Limitation of Liability**

The volunteer accepts that certain risks exist as an inherent part of travel in South Africa as well as working with wildlife and volunteers undertake the programme and associated activities entirely at their own risk. While Drakenstein Lion Park takes every precaution to ensure the safety of volunteers, no responsibility can be accepted for any death, injury or loss that might occur to such volunteers, sustained from any causes whatsoever. The volunteer and his/her dependents, heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, hereby indemnify and hold blameless, Drakenstein Lion Park, its members and employees from any claims of any nature and from any liability for delay, loss, damage, injury, illness or death arising from any cause whatsoever out of events related to or occurring during a programme.

### **12) Price Increase**

Drakenstein Lion Park reserves the right to increase program prices, although prices are fixed once the deposit is paid.

### **13) Defamation of Character**

Any client found to be defaming Drakenstein Lion Park programs or the character of any program personnel will immediately be asked to leave the program without a refund from Drakenstein Lion Park.

I hereby agree to be bound by the aforementioned application conditions. I further declare that the enrolment information submitted by me is complete and accurate. I realize that any false declaration by me would render any claim whatsoever void

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and I could further be liable for prosecution by the laws governing South Africa.

I understand that any activities undertaken during the Drakenstein Lion Park program is at my own risk and hereby indemnify Drakenstein Lion Park against any claims whatsoever that may arise in connection with any injury, loss or damage during the program, in the knowledge that the program leaders will take all reasonable precautions for the safety and welfare of the participants. I understand that costs in respect of any accident or illness which, in the opinion of the authorities, requires medical attention, are my liability.
